

**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR INCREASED ELECTION
INTEGRITY AND TRANSPARENCY IN GEORGIA**

WHEREAS the passage of SB 202 was a meaningful step toward election integrity in Georgia, and that it is imperative that voters in Georgia have faith and confidence in the integrity of their elections; including that their elected officials and their appointees, assigns, relatives, corporate interests, and agencies conduct elections in a legal, fair, secure, and constitutional manner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Georgia Republican Party calls for the Georgia Legislature to pass legislation and Governor to sign into law prior to the start of the candidate qualifying beginning March 1, 2024, the following measures:

1. The passage in its entirety of the FULL Georgia Republican Party's Election Confidence Task Force legislative package, including, but not limited to.
 - A. Eliminate no-excuse absentee by-mail voting, allowing absentee ballots only for voters who have a specific reason.
 - B. Replacing all Electronic voting systems with secure, serialized hand marked paper ballots.
 - C. 1 Day Voting for each election.
 - D. Smaller Precincts.
 - E. All ballots to be sealed in a clear plastic container with a documented serialized tag at the voting precinct, document to be posted on the County Website for FOIA Compliance.
 - F. Ballot containers are to be stored in a secure area with no possibility of unauthorized access.
 - G. Access to ballots shall be strictly controlled and monitored electronically.
 - H. The County Sheriff's office shall have 24x7x365 access to view live and recorded camera footage of said secure storage room.
