### Resolution Reprimanding Republicans Who Voted for HB206 the Georgia “Green New Deal”

**Whereas**, the GAGOP Platform position #11 states that “Economic freedom is the cornerstone of individual liberty and the private sector and free-market principles, are the best way to stimulate economic development rather than government subsidies or programs”; and

**Whereas**, many public-private partnerships violate the principle of limited government and free market capitalism outlined in our platform; and

**Whereas**, it is morally wrong for the government to redistribute wealth with tax dollars, discriminate against certain businesses with unfair tax treatment, and pick winners and losers among competitors in the free market; and

**Whereas**, environmental improvements to private property should be accomplished voluntarily with private funds; and

**Whereas**, HB 206 the “Georgia Green New Deal” passed the Georgia General Assembly and legislates the use of taxpayer dollars to pay for private property development to make the property more environmentally friendly (see lines 3 & 329-345).
